ADULT VACCINATION CLINICS

Clinic Services is committed to providing low- to no-cost vaccines for adults in an effort to increase immunization rates in our community and help stem the rise of vaccine-preventable diseases. We offer *occupational hepatitis B virus, pneumonia, pre-exposure human rabies, seasonal influenza, shingles, and Tdap* vaccines. To set up an appointment, please call 732-341-9700, ext. 7604.



CANCER EDUCATION AND EARLY DETECTION SCREENING CLINICS

The Ocean County Health Department (OCHD) offers breast and cervical screenings as a partner with the Community Medical Center Foundation and the New Jersey Cancer Education and Early Detection program (CEED). We also offer additional information on the availability of colorectal and prostate cancer screenings.



CHILDHOOD LEAD POISONING CASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

As part of its program to prevent and manage childhood lead poisoning, Clinic Services educates the public and health-care providers about childhood lead poisoning and ensures that lead-poisoned infants and children receive timely and effective medical and environmental interventions.



HIV COUNSELING AND TESTING / CARE AND TREATMENT CLINICS

The HIV/AIDS Program administered by the OCHD provides free and confidential HIV counseling and testing and HIV-related health services for those who do not have sufficient healthcare coverage to cover their HIV care needs. We work to provide primary medical care and essential support services for HIV/AIDS-infected individuals.



LIVE HEALTHY OCEAN COUNTY! CHRONIC DISEASE SCREENING CLINIC

Clinic Services, in conjunction with OCHD's Health Education department, plans, promotes and implements community-based programs that include medication management education and screening for high blood pressure, stroke risk, and osteoporosis for Ocean County residents. OPHTHALMOLOGY (EYE SCREENING) CLINIC

Ophthalmology and optometry specialists contracted with OCHD provide routine examinations for eye health, visual acuity and glaucoma, and are for those who do not have health insurance or are underinsured. For questions or to set up an appointment, please call 732-341-9700, ext. 7604.



SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASE TESTING AND TREATMENT CLINICS

OCHD provides free and confidential clinics that test for and treat HIV and other sexually transmitted diseases, including syphilis, gonorrhea, and Chlamydia, and provides access to sexual health education and contraception.



TUBERCULOSIS (TB) TESTING AND TREATMENT CLINICS

Clinic Services has several clinics that specialize in the education, prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of active and latent TB infection. Clinics are available for TB skin testing, chest x-rays for TB reactors, Quantiferon-TB Gold testing for high risk individuals, and active TB case management and treatment.
