In accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., the Ocean County Board of Health is requesting proposals (RFP) from agencies to provide Intoxicated Driver Resource Center (IDRC) Administration, Education, Screening, Evaluation and Referral Services for the Ocean County 12-Hour Intoxicated Driver Resource Program for the time period of October 1, 2019 –September 30, 2020.

Scope of Work

Education Classes, Assessment, Evaluation and Referral: The successful agency will be responsible for providing the Ocean County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center with the educational, screening, evaluation and referral services on a regular basis. The successful applicant will supervise, schedule, and coordinate their professional licensed or certified counseling staff consistent with requirements and qualifications. The selection of the professional staff must have the final approval of the Ocean County Health Department. All sessions must meet the Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) Intoxicated Driving Program requirements and curriculum. The successful applicant must function with a minimum of two (2) counselors, with at least one (1) being a Licensed Clinical Alcohol & Drug Counselor (LCADC). Additional counselors must, at a minimum, be prepared at the level of Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC). Classes generally range from 25 to 50 participants. The successful applicant shall be responsible for teaching the Intoxicated Driving Program classes. The staff teaching must be trained in the IDRC curriculum as per IDP. The applicant must also perform client screenings and evaluations for possible referral for further assessment. The successful applicant may utilize a third licensed counselor on the second day of the IDRC class should the census exceed 35 attendees. Documentation in NJSAMS at the time of the screening is required. The applicant will also be responsible for classroom security, conduct of all participants in and out of the classroom during the hours of the class, and for the provision of any interpreter services required by participants.

- Intoxicated Driving Education Classes will be held for 6 hours a day on two (2) consecutive days, Fridays & Saturdays from 9am-3pm at the Ocean County Health Department (OCHD), or at another location in Ocean County provided by the OCHD. An alternate location provided by the proposer will be considered if approved by the OCHD (see **Location of Services**).

- Clinical decisions and screening write ups will be the responsibility of the Licensed Clinical Alcohol & Drug Counselor (LCADC) or other appropriately licensed staff as approved by the OCHD. No interns are permitted to sign off on screenings or write ups.

- All involved counselors and staff members of the successful applicant will provide disclosure statements regarding current places of employment and affiliations in order to avoid conflict of interest *as per N.J.A.C.10:162-2.6*.

· The curriculum disseminated by the New Jersey Intoxicated Driving Program (IDP) will be followed and utilized for all classes and be provided at the Ocean County Health Department.

Administration: The successful bidder will be requested to provide to the Intoxicated Driver Resource Center (IDRC) one LCADC for the purposes of, but not limited to, chart review, and taking actions, consultation and IDRC client evaluation for a total of two to four hours per week.

Location of Services: 1. The Ocean County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center (IDRC) is located at the Ocean County Health Department, 175 Sunset Ave, Toms River, N.J. 08754. Space for the sessions will be provided at the Ocean County Health Department and will be scheduled throughout the year on Fridays and Saturdays or as arranged between the Ocean County Health Department and the successful applicant. Space may be provided by the Ocean County Health Department at another location in Ocean County if, for any reason, the Sunset Avenue site is unable to be utilized. 2. An alternate location from the one supplied by the Ocean County Health Department may be considered if submitted as part of the proposal by the applicant. The alternate facility must be located in Ocean County and must be approved by the Ocean County Health Department.

Additional Requirements:

The successful applicant agrees not to directly refer any clients to its own treatment program or other treatment programs where they or their counselors are employed in order to avoid a conflict of interest as per *N.J.A.C. 10:162-2.6*. The successful applicant will be required to sign non-conflict forms stating the same upon award and contract. In addition, all counselors teaching classes or performing screening for the IDRC program will sign a non-conflict stating that they

will not self-refer to their agency of employment or themselves as private practitioners and further, all employees of the provider, in either their official capacity or through private arrangements, are prohibited from assessing or treating patients referred for additional services.

The successful applicant must be able to hold a minimum of thirty-six (36) 12-hour sessions per year or as deemed necessary by the Ocean County IDRC.

The successful proposer is to be responsible for all documentation of accurate screening, evaluation, and referral to treatment following N.J.A.C. 10:162-4.2: Criteria for client referral to treatment. The proposer will be responsible for reporting in NJSAMS, and for assurance of the completion of the Intoxicated Driver Program Questionnaire, agreements to participate in treatment, records release and other statements which must be signed by the participant.

The successful proposer must be knowledgeable on and adhere to all related statutes, regulations and program requirements regarding the IDRC program as per N.J.A.C. 10:162. State meetings regarding updates and training, and the electronic documentation in NJSAMS, are the responsibility of the applicant, including all costs related thereto. Computer hardware and internet access for NJSAMS will be provided by the OCHD if the classes are held at the OCHD or its designated location in Ocean County. All counselors of the 12 hour program must be officially trained in the new IDRC curriculum.

The Ocean County Health Department will be responsible for the administrative tasks such as filing, typing, scheduling, and maintaining the collection of fees. The Ocean County Health Department is responsible for reporting compliance or /non-compliance of clients to the courts and to the Intoxicated Driving Program, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services, as well as referring clients for treatment with the appropriate paperwork. The successful proposer shall provide (if necessary) an interpreter for those clients that are in need of such service. Notification that a citizen in need of such service will be attending the IDRC class shall be given to the successful proposer by the Ocean County IDRC as soon as the IDRC is made aware of the need.

ALL SUBMISSIONS SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM INFORMATION:

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection criteria to be used in awarding a contract for the services described herein shall include:

1. Qualifications of the licensed or certified counselor(s) who will perform the required duties;
2. Experience in providing substance abuse counseling, prevention and education services, and references thereto;

3. Ability to perform the required duties in an effective and efficient manner, including staffing and familiarity with the Intoxicated Driving Program, *N.J.A.C. 10:162*, and the Intoxicated Driver Resource Center;
4. Experience providing services to diverse populations.
5. Experience working with clients with Mental Health/Co-occurring disorders.
6. Experience providing services to governmental agencies.
7. Thoroughness and completeness of the applicant's submittal.
8. Hourly rate per counselor to be charged to the OCHD IDRC.

The Ocean County Board of Health shall award a contract to the successful applicant that best meets the needs and interests of the Ocean County Health Department Intoxicated Driver Resource Program. The Ocean County Board of Health reserves the right to negotiate the terms and conditions of this contract with the successful applicant to obtain the most cost advantageous services for the Ocean County Health Department Intoxicated Driver Resource Program.

It is expressly agreed and understood that any approval by the Ocean County Board of Health of the services provided by the CONTRACTOR pursuant to this contract will not relieve the CONTRACTOR of the obligation to comply with the Act and to defend, indemnify, protect and save harmless the Ocean County Board of Health pursuant to this paragraph. It is further agreed and understood that the Ocean County Board of Health assumes no obligation to indemnify or save harmless the CONTRACTOR, its agents, servants, employees and subcontractors for any claim which may arise out of their performance of this Agreement. Furthermore, the CONTRACTOR expressly understands and agrees that the provision of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the CONTRACTOR'S obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the CONTRACTOR from any liability, nor preclude the Ocean County Board of Health from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of this Agreement or otherwise at law.

The Ocean County Board of Health does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status in the admission or access to, or treatment, or employment in its programs or activities. The Ocean County Board of Health shall allow access to any books, documents, papers and records of the contractor, which are directly pertinent to that specific contract.

Compliance is required with all applicable standards, orders, or requirements issued under 306 of the Clean Air Act, Section 508 of the Clean Water Act, Executive Order 11738 and Environmental Protection Agency Regulations (40 CRF, Part 15) which prohibits the use under non-exempt federal contracts, grants or loans of facilities included on the EPA list of violating facilities.

DISCLOSURE OF CONTRIBUTIONS

Disclosure of Contributions to New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC)

N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 establishes a new disclosure requirement for business entities. It requires that, when a business entity has received in any calendar year \$50,000 or more in public contracts with public entities, it must file an annual report with the Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC). The report shall disclose any contribution of money or any other thing of value, including an in-kind contribution, or pledge to make a contribution of any kind:

- To a candidate for or the holder of any public office having ultimate responsibility for the awarding of public contracts, or,
- To a political party committee, legislative leadership committee, political committee or continuing political committee.

The report will include all reportable contributions made by the business entity during the 12 months prior to the reporting deadline. ELEC will be promulgating a form and procedures for filing commencing in January 2007. ELEC can also impose fines for failure to comply with this requirement.

While the local unit has no role in this process, it is recommended that all bid or proposal specifications and contracts should include language notifying business entities of their potential obligation under the law. Such language could read as follows:

Starting in January 2007, all business entities are advised of their responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement of political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 if they receive contracts in excess of \$50,000 from public entities in a calendar year.
