Free, confidential services include:

- HIV testing and counseling with harm reduction, condom distribution, PrEP referrals, and treatment referrals
- Pregnancy testing and referrals for prenatal care, WIC referrals
- Referrals for substance misuse treatment and medication-assisted treatment and mental health services
- Overdose prevention and NARCAN® (naloxone) Nasal Spray use training and distribution
- STD screenings and treatment referrals
- Rapid Hepatitis C testing and referral for treatment
- Hepatitis A / B, TDAP, and seasonal influenza vaccinations
