WHEREAS, the week of April 17-23, 2022 has been proclaimed National Volunteer Week in recognition of the efforts of volunteers in Ocean County and all across the county who give so much of their time and resources to many causes; and

WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week is an opportunity to recognize the impact of volunteer service and the power of volunteers to tackle society's greatest challenges, to build stronger communities and be a force that transforms the world; and

WHEREAS, the theme for National Volunteer Week is Celebrate Service – an opportunity to shine a light on the people and causes that inspire us to serve. Volunteerism empowers individuals to find their purpose, to take their passion and turn it into meaningful change. When each of us, in our own way, answers the call to make a difference, we make progress in solving our most persistent problems, and create stronger communities and a more just society; and

WHEREAS, besides the benefits to society, scientific studies have shown that individuals who volunteer enjoy psychological and physical benefits, including increased satisfaction, improved sense of belonging, lower blood pressure, increased protection from Alzheimer's and decreased mortality; and

WHEREAS, volunteering is good for your health at any age, but it's especially beneficial in older adults. Studies have found that those who volunteer have a lower mortality rate than those who do not, even when considering factors like the health of the participants; and


WHEREAS, approximately 63 million Americans — 25% of the adult population — volunteer their time, talents, and energy to making a difference; and
