

RESOLUTION 231(22)

WHEREAS, in 1986, Congress designated the third full week in October to be International Infection Prevention Week, and since then, this week has helped to raise national awareness of the role infection prevention plays to improve patient safety; this year's theme is "The Future is Infection Prevention: 50 Years of Infection Prevention" — we want to highlight decades of infection prevention throughout APIC's 50 years and inspire the next generation of IPs to join the fight; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has shown the world what we've always known—infection preventionists (IPs) are essential to keeping the world safe. In addition to all the usual suspects (healthcare-associated infections, Monkeypox outbreaks, flu season, etc.), the infection prevention and control community is continuing to fight a global pandemic for the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, International Infection Prevention Week is a great time to remind everyone about hand cleaning, flu shots, COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters and other ways to protect themselves and their patients; and


