Bidders are cautioned to obtain and review the plans and specifications in advance of this date. The Board of Health will consider all requests for technical modifications to the plans and specifications and will, if necessary, issue an addendum.

Addenda will be issued only in the exceptional case where, the issue involved is of sufficient importance to materially affect the bidding process.
